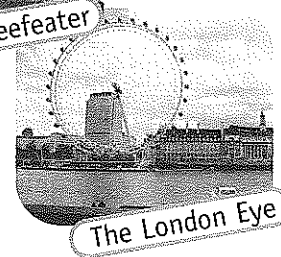
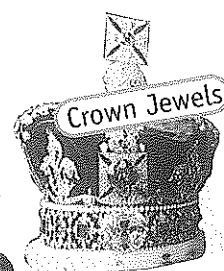
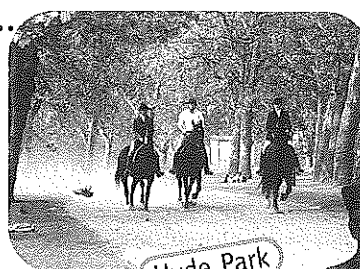
HOT SPOTS ON THE INTERNET
